PUBLIC SKATE & PARENTS, TOTS, SENIORS SKATE RULES OF CONDUCT

- All patrons must respect & follow all rules
- No food or drink on the ice
- No horseplay/games
- No skating backwards
- No figure skating maneuvers
- No erratic/excessive speed skating
- No balls/pucks/chairs/pylons/strollers /sticks or any other item that might interfere with the safety of any skater while on the ice
- No headsets, cell phones or hand held electronic devices are to be used while skating
- No carrying of children is permitted
- No sitting on the boards
- Skate with the direction of all skaters
- Patrons must conduct themselves appropriately at all times
- All participants must be wearing skates while on the ice surface
- No laying or sliding on the ice
- Skate supports are for beginner skaters only
- Helmets are strongly recommended
- Listen and adhere to the Skate Patrol at all times
